A Supported Internship is a transition to work programme where young people can learn about the workplace by being in work.

-  Are you 16-25 years old with an Education, Health and Care Plan?
-  Would you like to get a paid job in the future?
-  Do you have autism or a related learning difficulty?
-  Are you an independent traveller?

Supported Internships are a great opportunity for young people with autism to combine work with their education. Benefits of our Supported Internship:

- learning new skills that you can use in work in the future

- support from trained job coaches to help you succeed

- 800 hours of structured support from specialist staff, mentors and job coaches
- opportunities to gain accredited and practical qualifications
- the DFN Project Search programme has seen 60% of graduates securing a paid job (16 hours or more per week).

Supported Internships with Ambitious College at The Whittington Hospital.

Ambitious College is working with The Whittington Hospital in North London to offer Supported Internships.

Interns will be based at The Whittington Hospital for the academic year. With the support of staff from Ambitious College and The Whittington Hospital, interns will have the opportunity to develop a variety of workplace skills such as administration, maintenance, hospitality and housekeeping.

Supported Internships form part of the intern's education and are unpaid. This opportunity will equip young people with special educational needs and disabilities (SEND) with the skills needed for adulthood and employment.
